BIOGRAPHY

Deanna H. Choi is a Korean-Canadian composer and sound designer based in Toronto. She scores film, television, dance, and multimedia. Through her company **SPLIT BRAIN SOUND**, she designs soundscapes and audio systems for plays and musicals. Her work is collaborative, innovative, and ranges from classics in major theatres to experimental pieces in black boxes. She has been featured in conversation twice in the journal **Canadian Theatre Review** and is the second sound designer to win the prestigious **Pauline McGibbon Award** for Theatrical Design in the award's history. She is an associate artist with the **National Theatre School of Canada**.

Fortuitously named after a Star Trek character, Deanna pursued a degree in behavioural neuroscience with a theatre minor at Queen's University, trading her white lab coat during the day for stage blacks at night. Her findings were published in peer-reviewed journals (Frontiers in Psychology, Neuroplasticity), and her TEDxTalk on music's effects on the brain has been viewed over 300K times. The study of human perception and behaviour continues to inform her artistic practice, to develop a deeper understanding of storytelling and a relationship with the audience. She is developing a piece about the science of music performance with support from Necessary Angel. As a classically-trained violinist, having performed as a soloist, chamber musician, and orchestral player across Canada, Deanna highlights strings and orchestral textures in her work. She won the gold medal in violin performance from the Royal Conservatory of Music and has participated in artist residences at the Canadian Film Centre's Slaight Music Lab, the Banff Centre, National Youth Orchestra of Canada, and Stanford University. LOVE YOU WRONG TIME, a song cycle/cabaret performance Deanna co-created with Maddie Bautista, premiered in Toronto in 2023 and won two Dora Awards (out of 5 nominations).
